



10 Quick Interview Tips

1. Be sure to look up your interviewees on LinkedIn to gain knowledge on who you will be interviewing with. The more knowledgeable you are on the people you are meeting with the more prepared you will feel.
2. Do some research on the company before the interview, check out their website, recent press releases as well as recent media coverage they may have received.
3. Come prepared to ask questions to your interviewer(s). Be sure to ask questions that cover the company as a whole as well as the specific department you're interviewing for.
4. Pay attention to the culture of the organization and see how it fits with your specific personality and needs.
5. Be yourself.
6. Ask clarifying questions if the interviewer says something you don't understand or is confusing.
7. Make the interview as interactive as possible versus question and answer.
8. Dress for success; do not try to make a fashion statement.
9. If you want the position, ask for it.
10. Practice interviewing with someone before you come in to interview, ask a mentor or a good friend to ask you some questions, to get you in the comfort zone of interviewing.
